

Table Mountain Monday 8 October

The city began as a Dutch way station in the 16th century. Protecting and refreshing weary sailors as they passed the tip of Africa. It grew steadily through the centuries, fed on a diet of French settlers, Indonesian and Madagascan slaves and English colonists. A thriving farming and wine making industry was established thanks to the rich, fertile soils of the Cape. Today this rich history comes together in distinctive architecture and a unique local culture. South Africa's world-renowned icon, Table Mountain, was afforded National Park status in May 1998. Table Mountain offers something for everyone – magnificent views, cable car rides, mountain-biking, hiking, serious rock climbing, cross country running, fascinating botany, birding and for the more adventurous, abseiling and paragliding. Visitors are treated to a spectacular view during the ride to the top of Table Mountain aboard a modern cable car with a revolving floor.

Tour of Constantia via Chapman's Peak Drive Tuesday 9 October

Peak drive is often referred to as one of the most beautiful drives in the World. Constructed in the 1915, it took seven years to complete. The views are spectacular and absolutely breath-taking. Groot Constantia Wine Estate is the oldest wine estate in South Africa, established in 1679. You will have the opportunity to enjoy wine-tasting of 5 different wines, with canapés.


Wildlife/Safari Tour to Aquila Game Reserve Wednesday 10 October

Our mission is to promote, from a neutral base, the use of Trenchless Technology for providing and maintaining underground infrastructural services with minimum surface disruption.

In 2011 SASTT hosted the first ISTT masterclass in Southern Africa in conjunction with No-Dig South Africa. It was opened by the mayor of the capital city of South Africa; attended by 70 delegates; and the exhibition filled a hall measuring 1000 square metres.

SASTT has received recognition from the Institute of Municipal Engineering of Southern Africa by being designated a professional affiliate of the institute. There are currently more than 50 members, including three individual (pensioner) members.
